

Specifications may include the minimum distance from rail vehicles to railway platforms, buildings, lineside electrical equipment cabinets, signalling equipment, third rails or supports for overhead lines. A related but separate gauge is the loading gauge: a diagram or physical structure that defines the maximum height and width dimensions in railway vehicles and their loads. The difference between these two gauges is called the clearance.

The size of the clearance permits the wobbling or shifting of railway vehicles when they're moving at a fast speed. In some cases, a train can be allowed to move through a clearance at very low speed.
